## 第一天 出发 > 中转 > 慕尼黑 (德国)

### 机上用餐

- 集聚于国际机场, 乘坐豪华客机飞赴慕尼黑 - 德国首都巴伐利亚。

## 第二天 抵达慕尼黑 > 埃塔耳 (1.5小时) > 奥伯阿默高 (0.5小时) > 新天鹅城堡 (1小时) > 菲森 (0.5小时)

### 晚餐

- 抵达后, 我们将驱车向南前往埃塔耳。在美丽的埃塔耳修道院拍照留念, 该修道院坐落在巴伐利亚阿尔卑斯山脚下的埃塔耳小村庄, 以及游览南巴伐利亚时不容错过的令人印象深刻的巴洛克式建筑。
- 继续前往奥伯阿默高, 在圣彼得和保罗教堂拍照留念。
- 接下来参观德国最著名的城堡——新天鹅城堡 (含门票), 是德国境内受拍照最多的建筑物。
- 如果新天鹅城堡的预订爆满, 将被改为高天鹅堡取代。
- 夜宿于Fussen Luitpoldpark 酒店或同等级。

## 第三天 菲森 > 艾布塞 (1.5小时) > 楚格峰 (0.5小时) > 因斯布鲁克 (1.5小时)

### 早餐, 晚餐

- 早餐后, 前往艾布塞。缆车将从艾布塞到楚格峰山。
- 在登上海拔2932 米的德国最高峰楚格峰。令人叹为观止、令人印象深刻的360 度全景图让您着迷, 该全景图向您展示各国400 多座山峰的广阔景色。
- 在楚格峰进一步即可穿越奥地利蒂罗尔。
- 抵达因斯布鲁克, 游览蒂罗尔首府著名地标——因斯布鲁克大教堂和市政厅。黄金屋顶, 享受一些空闲时间探索这座拥有800 年历史的城市, 这座城市已成为世界上唯一一个举办过3届奥运会的城市。(1964、1976、2012)
- 夜宿于Innsbruck 酒店或同等级。

## 第四天 因斯布鲁克 > 施华洛世奇水晶世界 (0.5小时) > 贝希特斯加登盐矿 (2.5小时) > 萨尔茨堡 (1小时)

### 早餐, 晚餐

- 今天启程前往施华洛世奇水晶世界, 参观奥地利最受欢迎的景点之一, 施华洛世奇水晶世界商店, 选购最新设计和种类繁多的施华洛世奇产品。
- 接下来游览世界著名, 同时拥有近500年历史且仍然活跃的贝希特斯加登盐矿和盐博物馆的旧盐厂。了解古代和今天赢得和生产盐和卤水的所有值得了解的知识。
- 继续前往萨尔茨堡。
- 夜宿于FourSide Salzburg 酒店或同等级。

## 第五天 萨尔茨堡 > 哈尔施塔特 (1.5小时) > 萨尔茨堡 (1.5小时)

- 继续前往莫扎特的故乡萨尔茨堡。
- 欣赏广受喜爱的音乐剧“音乐之声”所依据的壮丽乡村的广阔景色。
- 探索莫扎特的出生地和老城区, 然后在格特莱德加斯购物街购买纪念品、巧克力等。
- 夜宿于FourSide Salzburg 酒店或同等级。

**Dinner**

- Overnight In Fussen Luitpoldpark Hotel or similar.

### DAY 3 FUSSEN > EIBSEE (1.5 HOURS) > ZUGSPITZE (0.5 HOURS) > INNSBRUCK (1.5 HOURS)

**Breakfast, Dinner**

- After breakfast, transfer to Eibsee. Cable car will be from **Eibsee to Zugspitze Mountain**.
- Ascend "Top of Germany" Zugspitze, Germany's highest peak at 2932m. Be mesmerize by the breathtaking, impressive 360 panorama which opens up to reveal extensive views over 400 mountain peaks in for countries.
- Crossing into Tirol Austria only 1 step away on **Zugspitze**.
- Arrive at **Innsbruck**, view the famous landmark in the Tyrolean capital, the Innsbruck Cathedral and City Hall.
- **Golden Roof** and enjoy some free time to explore this 800 years old city and that has entered the record books as the only city in the world to host 3 Olympic Games. (1964,1976, 2012)
- Overnight at Innsbruck Hotel or similar.

- Overnight at Salzburg Hotel or similar.

### DAY 5 SALZBURG > HALLSTATT (1.5 HOURS) > SALZBURG (1.5 HOURS)

- Today visit to **Hallstatt** - a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997. Nestled between the edge of Lake Hallstatt and the towering Dachstein Mountains, Austria's oldest and possibly most photographed village is something like a mirage in the Salzkammergut Lake region. Capture the delightful houses build into the mountains, the glass-like lake and the amazing mountains in the background.
- Continue journey to **Salzburg**, the hometown of Mozart. Enjoy the expansive view of the breathtaking countryside that the well-loved musical, "**The Sound of Music**".
- Explore **Mozart's Birthplace** and **Old Town** before browsing through the shopping street of **Getreidegasse** for souvenirs, chocolates, etc.
- Overnight at FourSide Salzburg Hotel or similar.
