第一天 出发 > 中转 > 北京

机上用餐

- 集聚于国际机场, 乘搭客机飞往北京。

第二天 抵达北京 > 大同 (2小时) (山西省)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 抵达后, 乘高铁前往大同。
- 游览世界文化遗产之云冈石窟 (含电瓶车) -- 云冈石窟共有大小窟龕252个, 石雕塑像51000余躯, 代表了公元5世纪至6世纪时中国杰出的佛教石窟艺术。云岗石窟于莫高窟, 龙门石窟以及麦积山石窟并称为中国四大石窟。
- 游览九龙壁, 是中国现存九龙壁中建筑年代最早、最大的一座。
- 大同古城 - 是一座拥有2300多年历史的北魏都城与明清军重镇, 享有“北方锁钥”美誉。其特色在于完整保留的明代风格城墙、规整的里坊制棋盘格局以及丰富的历史古迹。
- 夜宿于大同柳莺酒店或同级。

第三天 大同 > 呼和浩特 (2.5小时) > 希拉穆仁草原 (1.5小时)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 乘车前往内蒙古自治区的首府--呼和浩特市。
- 后再前往游览希拉穆仁草原, 是典型的沙化和高原草原。希拉穆仁蒙古语意为“黄色的河”, 俗称“召河”。
- 抵达后, 接受蒙古族隆重的草原迎宾仪式 - 下马酒仪式。
- 蒙古族传统文化体验: 穿蒙古袍拍照打卡、射箭体验、学蒙语、烫毡画。
- 蒙古族游牧文化体验: 观看男儿三艺表演 (马上竞技、马上叼羊、马上射箭、摔跤表演等)、熬制奶茶、与羊驼、小羊互动越野车草原深度穿越: 祭拜敖包山、深度穿越无人区。
- 来草原体验一次风驰电掣的快感——草原网红急速轨道滑草 (每人一次)
- 晚餐安排草原烤全羊风味+祝颂及开全羊仪式。
- 夜宿于草原商务空调蒙古包。

第四天 希拉穆仁草原 > 呼和浩特 (1小时) > 鄂尔多斯 达旗 (2小时)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 早晨有机会参观草原日出。(视天气而定)
- 哈达门国家森林公园 (景交车+电瓶车)、迷雾森林、桦林沟、高原牧场、云海秋千、木达栈道等。
- 哈素海景区 - (电瓶车、圣主广场、呼和敖包)
- 夜宿于鄂尔多斯达旗黄河阳光酒店。

第五天 鄂尔多斯 > 响沙湾 (0.5小时) > 鄂尔多斯 (1小时)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 今早启程前往响沙湾。途中停留达旗赵大剪 (剪纸博物馆+非遗剪纸体验)
- 5A景区银肯响沙湾 (缆车往返、仙沙岛: 骑骆驼、果老剧场、全地形车、轨道自行车、沙袜、滑沙)
- 特别安排: 滑沙体验一次, 中国三大响沙之一, 在这里滑沙, 是件十分惬意的事, 坐在沙丘上, 双腿前伸, 用力下滑时, 耳畔会响起“嗡嗡”的轰鸣声。
- 夜宿于鄂尔多斯智选假日酒店或同级。

第六天 鄂尔多斯 > 呼和浩特 (3小时)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 乘车前往蒙古帝国第一代大汗成吉思汗的衣冠冢, 简称成陵。由于蒙古族盛行“密葬”, 所以真正的成吉思汗陵在何处始终是个谜。成吉思汗的陵园参观行宫、寝宫。成吉思汗一生的描绘以及了解这位古代伟人的成人经历。成吉思汗陵园犹如三座蒙古包金顶大殿, 更似苍劲欲飞, 搏击长空 (含电瓶车)。缅怀成吉思汗即元太祖的丰功伟绩。
- 康巴什城市旅游区、美岱召。然后驱车前往内蒙古自治区首都-呼和浩特。
- 宽巷子美食街 - 巷子是集特色美食, 休闲购物, 网红打卡, 已有百年历史, 多年来不仅备受市民青睐, 更是原道而来旅游观光的游客寻味青城的首选打卡之地。特别安排: 网红宽巷子稀果羹每人一杯。
- 夜宿于呼和浩特希尔顿欢朋酒店或同等级。

第七天 呼和浩特 > 北京 (2小时)

早餐, 午餐, 晚餐

- 早上前往游览昭君博物馆, 称昭君墓, 又称“青冢”, 是史籍记载和民间传说中汉朝明妃王昭君的墓地。(昭君博物馆于每周二休息)
- 午餐后驱车返回动车赴北京。
- 夜宿于北京木棉花酒店或同级。

第八天 北京 > 中转 > 回程

早餐, 机上用餐

- 早餐后, 送往机场乘搭客机飞返回国。带着美丽的回忆抵达温馨的家园。

DAY 1 DEPARTURE > TRANSIT > BEIJING

MOB

- Assemble at International Airport for your departure flight to **Beijing**.

DAY 2 BEIJING > (2 HOURS) DATONG (SHANXI PROVINCE)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Upon arrival, take the high-speed train to **Datong**. Upon arrival, Mongolian grand prairie welcome ceremony - dismounting wine ceremony.
- Visit the **Yungang Grottoes** (including electric cart ride) a World Cultural Heritage site. The Yungang Grottoes comprise 252 caves and niches, containing over 51,000 stone sculptures, representing outstanding Buddhist cave art from the 5th to 6th centuries AD. The Yungang Grottoes, along with the Mogao Grottoes, Longmen Grottoes, and Maijishan Grottoes, are known as the four major grottoes of China.
- Visit the **Nine-Dragon Wall**, the oldest and largest existing Nine-Dragon Wall in China.
- Datong Ancient City** - a Northern Wei capital with over 2,300 years of history and a key military town during the Ming and Qing dynasties, known as the "Key to the North." Its distinctive features include well-preserved Ming Dynasty-style city walls, a well-organized grid-like layout of neighborhoods, and abundant historical sites.
- Overnight stay at Datong Liuying Hotel or similar.

DAY 3 DATONG > HOHHOT (2.5 HOURS) > XILAMUREN GRASSLAND (1.5 HOURS)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Travel to **Hohhot**, the capital of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region.
- Visit **Xilamuren Grassland**, a typical desertified and high-altitude grassland. Xilamuren means "yellow river" in Mongolian, and is commonly known as "Zhahe".
- Upon arrival, receive a grand **Mongolian welcome ceremony** - the "dismounting wine" ceremony.
- Experience traditional Mongolian culture: take photos in Mongolian robes, try archery, learn Mongolian, and participate in felt painting Mongolian princes.
- Mongolian nomadic culture experience: Watch performances of the "Three Manly Skills" (horseback racing, horseback goat-grabbing, horseback archery, wrestling, etc.), brew milk tea, interact with alpacas and lambs, and enjoy an in-depth off-road grassland adventure: worship at the Aobao Mountain and traverse the uninhabited area.
- Experience the thrill of high-speed grass skiing on the grassland - a popular attraction (one time per person).
- Dinner includes a whole roasted lamb feast, a traditional Mongolian New Year's Eve celebration, and a **whole lamb-opening ceremony**.
- Overnight stay in an air-conditioned Mongolian yurt on the grassland.

DAY 4 XILAMUREN GRASSLAND > HOHHOT (1 HOUR) > ORDOS DAQI (2 HOURS)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- There is an opportunity to **watch the sunrise over the grassland** in the morning. (Weather permitting)
- Hadamen National Forest Park** (scenic shuttle bus + electric car), **Misty Forest, Birch Valley, Alpine Pasture, Cloud Sea Swing, Muda Boardwalk**, etc.
- Hasuhai Scenic Area** - (electric car, Shengzhu Square, Huhe Aobao)
- Overnight stay at the Yellow River Sunshine Hotel in Ordos Daqi.

DAY 5 ORDOS > XIANGSHAWAN (0.5 HOURS) > ORDOS (1 HOUR)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- This morning, we will depart for **Xiangshawan**. En route, we will stop at **Daqi Zhao Dajian** (Paper-cutting Museum + Intangible Cultural Heritage Paper-cutting Experience).
- The 5A-rated scenic area, **Yinken Xiangshawan** (round-trip cable car, Xiansha Island: camel riding, Guolao Theater, ATV, rail bike, sand socks, sand boarding)
- Special arrangement: **Sandboarding Experience**. One of China's three major singing sand dunes, sand boarding here is a very pleasant experience. Sitting on the dune, stretching your legs forward, and sliding down with force, you will hear a "buzzing" roar in your ears.
- Overnight stay at the Holiday Inn Express Ordos or similar.

DAY 6 ORDOS > HOHHOT (3 HOURS)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- Travel by car to the cenotaph of **Genghis Khan**, the first Great Khan of the Mongol Empire, also known as the **Genghis Khan Mausoleum**. Due to the prevalence of secret burials among the Mongols, the location of the actual mausoleum of Genghis Khan remains a mystery. Visit the mausoleum complex, including the palace and sleeping quarters. Learn about Genghis Khan's life and his experiences as an adult. The Genghis Khan Mausoleum complex resembles three golden-roofed yurts, seemingly poised to take flight (including electric cart ride). Reflect on the great achievements of Genghis Khan, the Great Khan of the Yuan Dynasty.
- Kangbashi City Tourist Area** and **Meidaizhao Temple**. Then drive to **Hohhot**, the capital of Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region.
- Kuanxiangzi Food Street** - Kuanxiangzi is a century-old alleyway combining specialty foods, leisure shopping, and popular photo spots. It has been favored by locals for many years and is a top choice for tourists seeking the flavors of Hohhot. Special arrangement: One cup of Kuanxiangzi fruit soup per person.
- Overnight stay at the Hilton Garden Inn Hohhot or similar.

DAY 7 HOHHOT > BEIJING (2 HOURS)

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

- In the morning, visit the **Zhaojun Museum**, also known as the Zhaojun Tomb or "Green Tomb," the burial site of Wang Zhaojun, a famous concubine of the Han Dynasty, as recorded in historical records and folk legends. (The Zhaojun Museum is closed every Tuesday.)
- After lunch, drive back to **Beijing** by high-speed train.
- Overnight at the Beijing Kapok Hotel or similar.

DAY 8 HOHHOT > TRANSIT > PENANG

Breakfast, MOB

- After breakfast, transfer to airport for your departure flight back home.
- Arrive home with happy memories and till we meet again.
